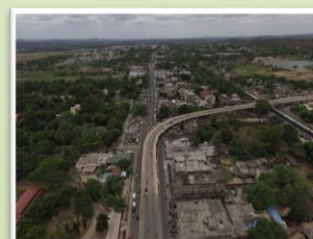

Some of the Key Features of Smart City Solutions



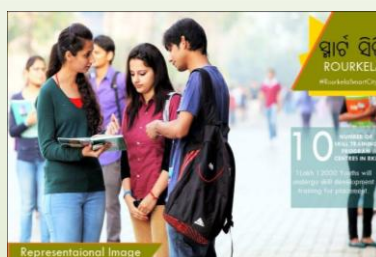
Smart Shelter House, Parking Facility to Smart Lighting Facility. RMC has implemented the Free Shelter House Project for the needy people and more to be implemented.

The world is seeing surveillance as a shortcut to security. Like the Latin American countries are using the DRONE and CCTV for the security purpose & citizens suggested for the same.



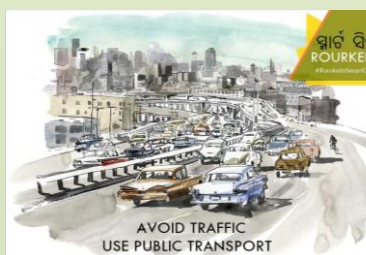
Rourkela to introduce Solar Rickshaws in Rourkela for the first time for the noise free and pollution free city.



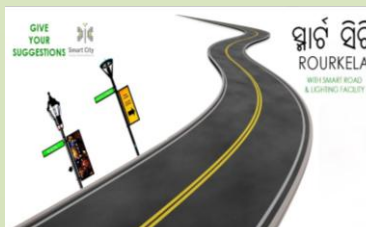
Citizens suggested for digitization of schedules, routes, bus stop locations. Also a smart app for riders update and alert.

Slum Sensitization Meeting cum Folk Media Show

With the support of District level NGO- SANTI and RRDC, under IEC/BCC activity National Urban Health Mission, Rourkela is undertaking Slum Sensitization Meeting cum Folk Media Show in 46 nos. of Slums in Rourkela City from 22nd June 2016. The main objective of the program was to create awareness among the slum dwellers of the city on the different entitlement of NUHM, Fixed day activities, Non Communicable Disease, Community Process activities, MDD (Malaria, Dengue & Diarrhea) etc. The event is being done in two part i.e. at first the HW (F) will have a brief discussion with the participants on above mentioned topics and then the cultural troupes will perform on the same.
