Forest Right Committee Meeting



A special drive was undertaken by the Administrator, RMC for facilitating the implementation of Forest Right Acts in the urban local body by Rourkela Municipal Corporation. 13 nos. of Basti unit on forest land in Rourkela Municipal Corporation area had been identified; Forest Right Committee in 05 Basti, namely Tangarpali, RTU-48, DAV Hill Side, Jharana Basti Ward No.7, Khadia Basti and Ice Factory Ward No.9 had been formed in 2016.

The FRC formation in rest 08 basti namely Jail Road Ward No.6, Church Basti Ward No.11, Ganjam-Jugal Basti Ward No.11, Amarnath Basti Ward No.11, Gopabandhupali Basti Ward No.13, Dakshin Kantajhar Ward No.30, Hairhar Basti, Chhend Ward No.32 & 33. The basti dwellers have been scrutinised on the provision and aspects of the Forest Right Act by the Community Organisers of RMC, with the help of Revenue & Forest Field Officials. 226 nos. of cases have been recorded and 96 claims verified by the FRC members with the help of Revenue & Forest Officials.

Interacting Meeting on PMAY at Madhusudanpali & Malgodam

An meeting on PMAY was held on dt.24.05.2017 at Anganwadi Center, Malgodam, Ward No.10. The details discussion was made on the different services of U-MHU i.e. treatment of minor ailments and malaria, activity

under Blindness control programme, RCH service, motivation for promotion of family planning methods among the EC, detection of NCD cases and early referral, initiation of necessary steps towards epidemic management & control as and when require, promotion of good health seeking behavior among the community through ASHA/MAS, Conduct of Health Education session etc, Medicine Indenting system, Micro plan, timing of U-MHU, display of IEC material etc. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair and other participants in the meeting.

Operationalization of Urban Mobile Health Unit (U-MHU) in Rourkela City in PPP Mode



Since April 2017 the Urban MHU is operationalizing in Rourkela city with the partnership of NGO, GJS. The U-MHU is providing preventive, promotive and curative health care services at their doorsteps on routine manner and thereby creating an enabling environment through awareness generation for improved health seeking behavior towards public health. As per the micro plan the team is moving to the different slums areas and providing the health services. The major thrust area of the MHU is consultation, screening and referral. The different services are proving are: General Service, RMNCH+A Service, Family Planning Service, Non Communicable Disease, Various Disease Control Programme, Diagnosis, IEC/BCC and Counseling etc.
