Ramakanta Mohapatra aged about 42 years from an economically challenged family staying with his wife and one daughter at Timber Colony, ward No-13 of Rourkela Municipal Corporation. He is doing Cycle repairing shop in front of his house situated at main road side. He is earning profit of average Rs 5000-6000 per month.

The Prospective Journey





Being the only earning member of the family with this income it was very difficult to survive. In the early period he was not able to maintain variety of cycle spare parts in his shop due to his poor financial condition for which he was unable to earn sufficient profit from the business to maintain his family and to bear the tuition fee of his daughter who is now doing diploma at SK DAV Polytechnic, Rourkela. In the meantime he came to know about the SEP (I) component of DAY-NULM programme of Rourkela Municipal Corporation. Determined to overcome his financial challenges he applied for loan under SEP-I component to expand his business. After taskforce approval the application send to Indian Overseas Bank, Bisra Road, Rourkela branch. After due verification, bank is pleased to disburse an amount of Rs 50,000/-. After that he is able to maintain variety of cycle spare parts as per the local requirement and earning profit of Rs 10-12 thousand rupees per month and also able to provide tuition fee for his daughter. He is now paying the EMI of loan to the bank in right time. Now he is happy with his business.
