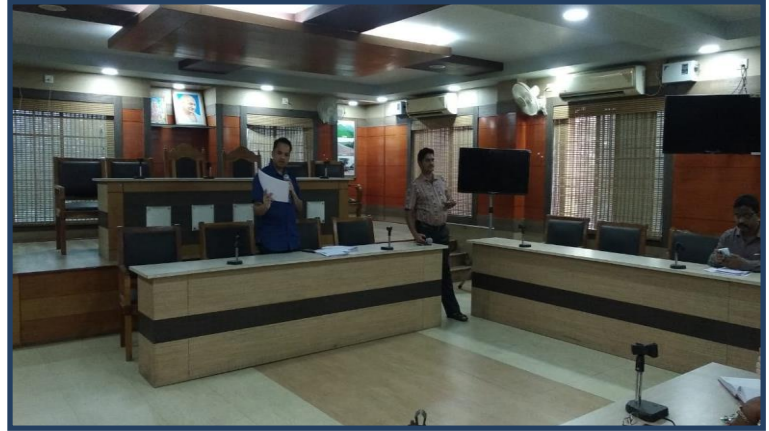

During the tough & challenging time, #TeamRourkelaMunicipalCorporation have carried out the Fogging activities at various places of the city.



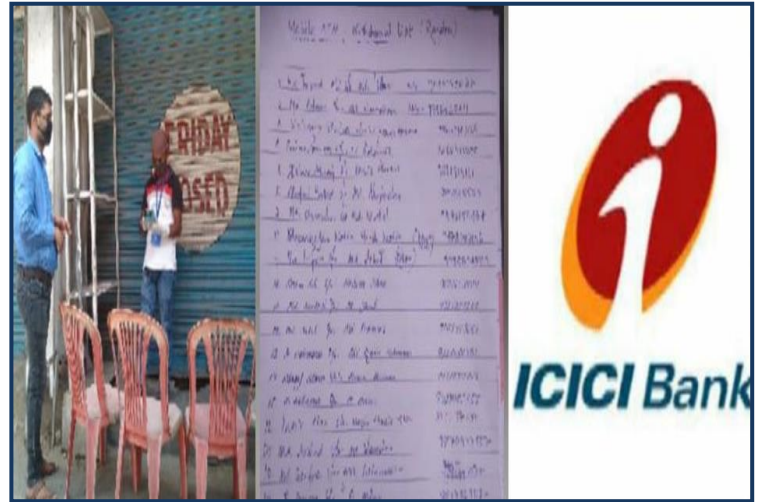

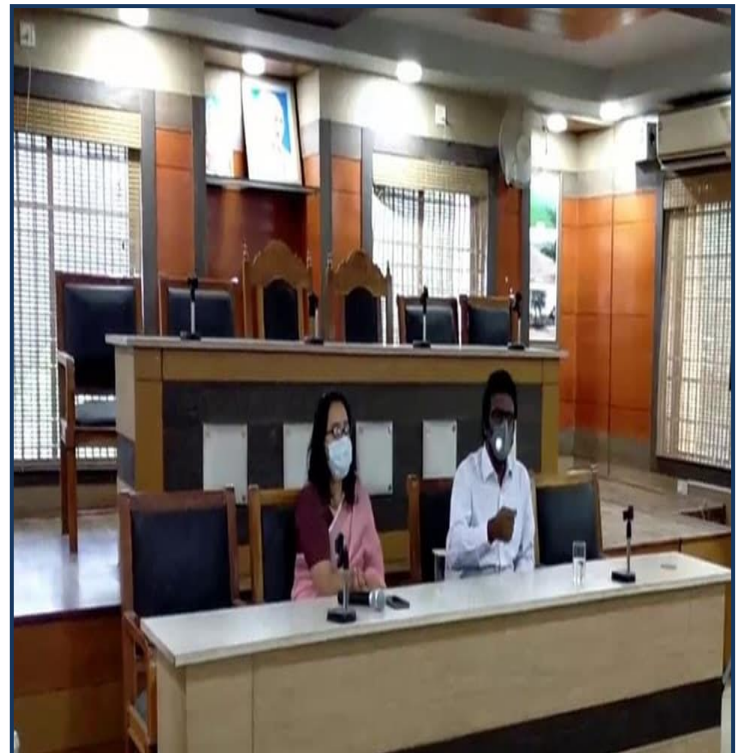

Door to Door surveillance was conducted in all the areas of the city by #Team #RMC to identify COVID-19 symptomatic cases. Ward level teams have formed and dedicated ward officers have designated to lead the team.



#RMC have take this challenge to beat #CORONA with full of sincerity. Our dedicated #Team have sanitizing the city from the very beginning. Tractor mounted Boom Sprayer Machine & BHEL Mist Machine have eased our efforts in sanitizing the city.



Ward level Covid Management Committees have formed by #RMC and the committee members meet regularly to discuss and carryout strategies / tasks to beat #CORONA at the field level, maintain social distance and by adhering all related guidelines.
